The Congress Street Hill Property, LLC is applying for an U.S. EPA Brownfields Cleanup Grant for funding proposed remediation activities at the Old Waldo County Jail and Jailer's House Site located at 45 Congress Street in Belfast, Maine. The application will be submitted to the U.S. EPA on or before November 19, 2012. The proposed remediation will likely include excavation/capping of petroleum contaminated soils, installation of a soil vapor mitigation system, and/or the abatement of asbestos, lead based paint, and other potential hazardous building materials.

Draft copies of the grant application will be available for public review and comment beginning Monday, November 5, 2012 at the offices of the Waldo County Commissioners Office, located at 39B Spring Street in Belfast.
